Happy Easter!

May 5, 2019

Yes, we're still celebrating Easter - for a full 50 days! It's a great time to celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus, which is the big event that proves Jesus is who he says he is. He is exactly the person we believe him to be, which is the Eternal Word of the Father. These are meant to be powerful days in the life of the Church, filled with God's grace and favor. Last weekend we celebrated Divine Mercy Sunday, a day with a strong connection to receiving the mercy and forgiveness of God through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The Lord wants to bring about renewal in his Church during these days, especially in the individual members of that Church. These are perfect days for each of us to come before the Lord and ask for healing, whether physical, mental, or spiritual. Approach him in the Blessed Sacrament and ask him to be powerful in your life.

This month of May is traditionally dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. There is even a big feast day at the end of the month, the Visitation (31st). It's on this day that we recall Mary's eagerness to share the joy of pregnancy with her cousin Elizabeth. Both were pregnant, Mary with Jesus and Elizabeth with John the Baptist. The main highlight that jumps out at me in this scene from Luke 1:39-56 is Mary's focus on the Lord and on Elizabeth. We see her going in haste to visit her cousin and share the joy of Elizabeth's unexpected pregnancy, and then later she sings a great song of praise to the Lord for the favor she has received from him (this song is called the *Magnificat*). As she arrives, she becomes a great evangelist, bringing Jesus with her wherever she goes. A beautiful image for us: As Christians, we bring Jesus with us wherever we go, making every encounter with people an opportunity for evangelization. Also in the month of May is the memorial of Our Lady of Fatima (13th).

We also had this month, our parish Feast Day, the Feast of St. Philip (and James) on the 3rd. It's such a great thing for us to celebrate our identity as a parish dedicated to St. Philip the Apostle, one of Jesus' closest friends and first followers. Be sure to mark your calendars for next year and find a good way to celebrate our great saint. The Feast of St. James, also an Apostle, is the same day since the two are buried in the same basilica in Rome. There's also another Feast day on the 14th for St. Matthias, who is the Apostle chosen to replace Judas Iscariot after the Ascension. With some other good saints this month, here are some highlights: St. Isidore (15th) is the patron saint of farmers, which is big in the Diocese of Crookston; St. Joseph the Worker (1st) is a memorial that reminds us of the goodness of hard work; St. Damien of Molokai (10th) was a missionary to the natives of Hawaii; St. Rita of Cascia (22nd) was married to a difficult man and eventually won him over by her humility and prayers, and joined religious life after his death; and St. Mary Magdalene de Pazzi (25th) was a Carmelite nun whose body is still incorrupt and preserved in a glass coffin in Florence, Italy. There are so many great witnesses to Jesus for us to behold. Let's resolve to be powerful witnesses for the people around us.

May the Lord give you his peace!

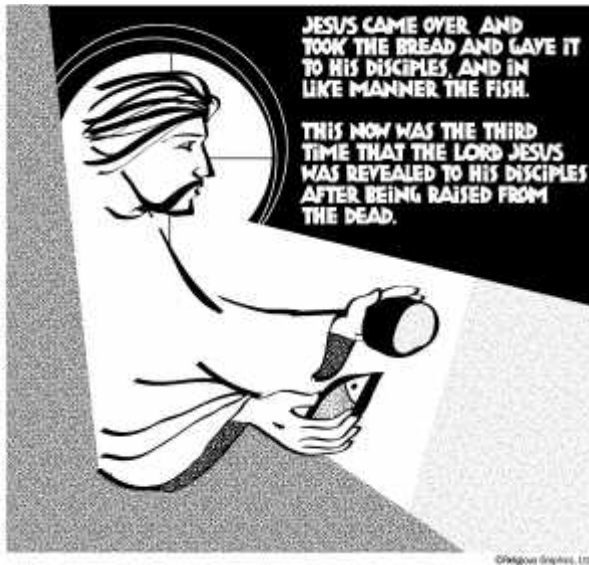

“And I Will Make You fishers of Men”

Anyone can fish but one need learn the basics. Fishing requires some equipment—tool, so to speak. A sturdy yet flexible ‘rod’ to hold on to and a ‘reel’ to bring them in. You’ll need fishing line—an invisible thread that leads you to where the fish are. The amount of line will vary whether the fish are in shallow or deep waters; causing you to go to great lengths to catch them. Beneath the surface is where you will ‘lure them’ with a wide variety of bait. This can vary greatly—some will be attracted immediately but others may require just the right lure to hook them. As you begin to reel them in, some are drawn in with ease while others resist and even run a great distance. Now is the call for the fisherman to be patient yet strong in his/her determination to bring them in. If you do not give them some time and distance to ‘run’ a bit, and you run the risk of them breaking the line—the only thread that connects you to them. And so you wait and watch and allow them time and space. It is a balance for the fishermen too. It can be a difficult process as things play out. You watch them run and you may worry about the outcome—humorous scenarios can occur while you allow things to unfold.

The call is to remain hopeful during this time and to even enjoy the time as you wait and watch and pray. Trust in the rod and have faith that your grip is well placed. Never forget the invisible line which connects you to them and the lengths you will go to catch them. Remember that deep beneath the surface, they are still holding the bait; from the beginning. Allow them to ‘chew’ on it and let the hook work its way in. Trust that eventually they will be pulled in—with less chance of letting them slip from your grip. Over time you will draw them into the boat and you will be carried together to the other side. That’s what Faith can do!
