In our Gospel reading for today, Jesus said: "My sheep hear my voice, I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish."

May each of us here at St. Philip's, and may St. Philip's as a parish family, always hear and recognize God's voice and follow him.

I am so grateful to God that I am here as a member of this parish family, and that I have all of you faithful followers of God as examples for me. I have witnessed many of you do as Paul and Barnabas, in our first reading today, speak out boldly the message of Jesus. The faith, prayer life and example of Christian witness that I observe from seeing you living your daily lives inspires me and challenges me to be a better Christian disciple. Thank you for your witness!

As we approach the end of another school year I would like to encourage all of you to pray for vocations. Please pray for the young men of our parish to be open to, and to be willing to respond to a call from our Lord and Savior, to consider entering path to the priesthood. I would encourage you to not only pray for this, but if you know a young man from our parish that you feel would make a good priest, that you would let him know how you feel. Give him a phone call, or a text or email, or even better, talk to him face to face and tell him that you are praying that he would consider becoming a priest.

I would also like to encourage the men in our parish, between the age of 35 and 60, to consider the idea of becoming a Deacon. Have you ever felt that God may be calling you to do more for your faith? Have you ever seen Deacon Robb or myself participating in ministry and said to yourself, I wonder what that is like, or could that be for me? If so, please give me a call or stop in and visit with me. I would love the chance to share with you what a wonderful blessing it is to be a Deacon. And, I would love to pray with you, asking God if he may be calling you to be of service to him in this way. It will be a couple of years before our diocese will again be accepting applications for the diaconate program.

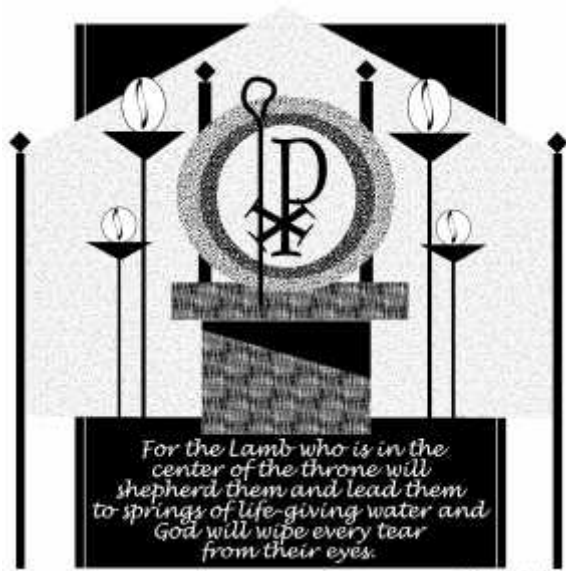

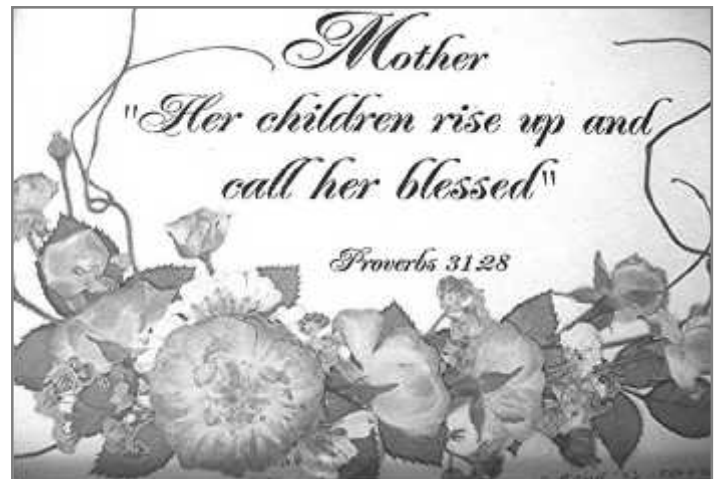
