Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

May 19, 2019

A great lesson we can all learn from this week's Gospel would be for each of us to examine the ways Jesus loves so we can do the same. Jesus' love is manifested in effective words and actions. Should we want to be His disciples, we need to do the same. It is what He commands us.

In this week's Gospel, Jesus gives His disciples the condition of discipleship: "*Love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another.*" To fulfill His command, we need to look at how Jesus loved and thoughtfully consider how we can manifest that kind of love today as Jesus' disciples.

- Jesus' love is unconditional: While hanging on the cross in agony, he forgave those who crucified him. Can we have the strength to forgive those who have severely injured us?
- Jesus' love was sacrificial. His first great sacrifice was becoming human. Jesus accepted the limits of time and space to embrace our humanity so that he could save us. Are we willing to make necessary sacrifices in our own lives to demonstrate our love for others?
- Jesus loved social outcasts as well as the rich leaders: Jesus dined with prostitutes and tax collectors - as well as with Jewish leaders, the Pharisees, and scribes. Are we able to shed our reluctance to love and understand those who are outside our social position?
- Jesus treated all as equals: Jesus healed lepers and the Roman centurion's servant. He washed the feet of the disciples and healed the pagan Syro-Phoenician woman's daughter. Will we be able to give our love equally to everyone, even when it may be considered by others to be undignified?
- Jesus' love was compassionate: Jesus had compassion for the widow of Nain and raised her only son to life. Jesus saw a hungry crowd and multiplied loaves and fish to feed them. Will we be able to show genuine sympathetic pity and concern for the sufferings or misfortunes of others?
- Jesus sometimes broke the letter of the law to follow the law of love: Jesus healed on the sabbath and defended his hungry disciples for eating standing grain on that day. Both were considered "work" and forbidden by the Jewish law.

If we truly want to be our Lord's disciples, we cannot do it on our own. We must first ask for His help. He will send His Spirit upon us and make it possible for us to be more like Him. When we come together to celebrate the Mass, we benefit from one of Jesus' greatest gifts of love: the gift of Himself in the Eucharist. His Spirit becomes alive in us and helps us to love as He did. Jesus said, "*This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another*" (*John 13:35*). What can each one of us do to make that kind of love evident in our Church today?
