Happy Father's Day!

June 16, 2019

This Sunday, as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, we also honor our earthly fathers. We profess in our creed: we believe in one God, the Father almighty, in Jesus Christ his only begotten Son and in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and Giver of life. One God in three persons, in perfect, right-relationship with one another.

We profess our love not only for God the Father, but also for our Father's here on earth, who, along with our Mothers, help to teach and awaken within us our faith in the persons of the Trinity.

This weekend's scripture texts help us to understand more fully our Triune God, and show us how they relate to us: the Wisdom of God, the human and divine natures of Jesus, through whom we have peace with God, and the Holy Spirit who proceeds from them both and is the Spirit of truth. In the whole of Scripture, we can see the hand of our Triune God as He loves and cares for us.

God is the Creator, the Protector and the Judge of all creation, especially the greatest of all His creation – us. God's promise to bring about salvation became a reality in the person of Jesus Christ. Jesus makes another promise. He promises to send us the Holy Spirit, and He keeps this promise, the Holy Spirit comes upon us, and our Church is born.

We believe in one God, a Trinity of Persons, who work in perfect accord to provide us a way home. The doctrine of the Trinity can be difficult to grasp. But having faith and being in a relationship with a Triune God doesn't have to be because our God is a God who is for us. He created us in his image, came down from heaven and lived among us, and continues to be with us in truth, and as our strength and guidance. Everything he does, he does for us. How could we not respond in kind to such a love?

So, as we celebrate this doctrine of our faith, let us give thanks for the mystery of our redemption by God, through Christ in the power of the Holy Spirit. Let us also give thanks not only for this divine outpouring of pure gift for our sake, but also for our gift of human fathers. May we respond to all our God-given gifts by glorifying God, by living in right-relationship with Him and with one another.
