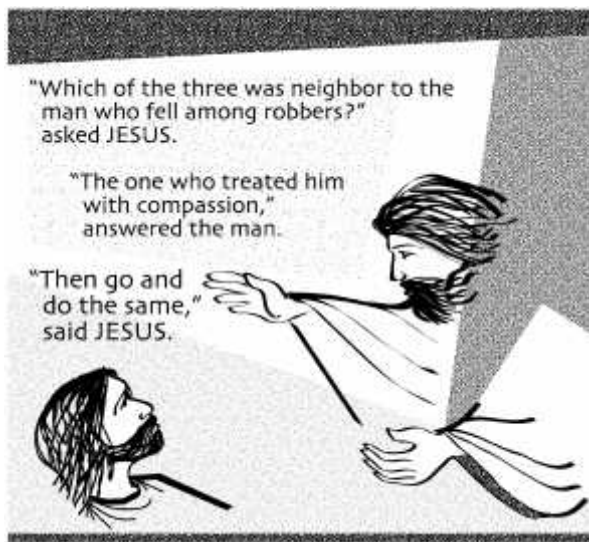

This was Jesus' command at the end of the Good Samaritan story. Did you know that the Samaritans and Jews despised each other. The moral of the story is to love our neighbor. That means loving someone you may not know or someone that looks different than you or someone that you don't like. All without expecting anything in return.

Rotate to Donate

Many households have cupboards with close-dated or outdated foods that have little chance of being consumed in the near future. This July, St. Philip's Church is conducting a Rotate to Donate collection of these boxed or canned goods. Individuals with older items can donate them to the Bemidji Community Food Shelf (BCFS) and purchase newer products as needed for their own use. Qualified staff will inspect each package to determine its viability before making the goods available to clients who depend on the Food Shelf to feed themselves and their families.



Last year the BCFS was the 15th busiest of the 330 Food Shelves in Minnesota. Bemidji ranks 71st in the state in size, which means many larger Food Shelves served fewer people. In 2018, our Food Shelf distributed almost 360 tons of food to 3000 households. An estimated 1.5 million meals were provided to individual children, adults and senior citizens.

St. Philip's will participate in the Rotate to Donate project with collections held prior to masses on July 20-21. Please open your cupboards and Rotate to Donate food. New packaged foods or monetary donations would also be accepted.

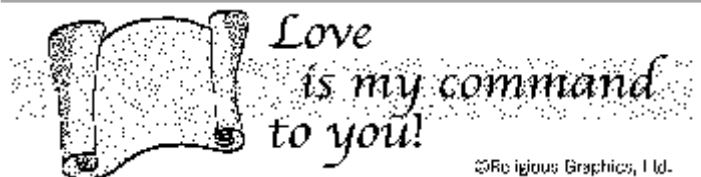


Abortion: It's About Women's Rights
