The Gospel for this 14th weekend of 'Ordinary Time' describes the image of Jesus sending out the 72 disciples two by two. The rationale is the concern that there is much work to do but few laborers are available.

This is sometimes viewed as a prelude to the post-resurrection image (Acts 6:1) wherein the apostles were concerned about more work than laborers. As recounted by Luke, both in his Gospel and in the sixth chapter of Acts, the solution was to call additional people to help.

Note the similarity comparing Luke's Gospel and chapter six of his writing in Acts.
