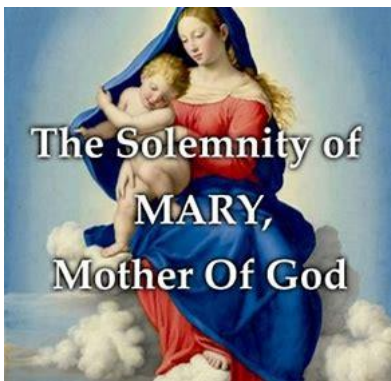

The Sunday that follows Christmas is always the celebration of the **Holy Family**. There are wonderful readings from the Book of Sirach, the First Book of Samuel, and Paul’s letter to the Colossians or the First Letter of John. The gospel is the story of the teen aged Jesus teaching in the temple while his parents could not find him. Jesus goes back home with his family. “He went down with them and came to Nazareth and was obedient to them; and his mother kept all these things in her heart. And Jesus advanced in wisdom and age and favor before God and man.”



Like Christmas Week, this week is filled with special Church celebrations. Tuesday is the **Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary**, The Mother of God. It is also the **World Day of Peace**. Wednesday is the **Memorial of Saints Basil the Great and Gregory Nazianzen**, Bishops and Doctors of the Church. Thursday has the optional memorial of the **Holy Name of Jesus**. Friday is the **Memorial of Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton**, Religious. Saturday is the **Memorial of Saint John Neumann**, Bishop.

The first reading during the week continues from the **First Letter of John**, encouraging us to make our home in the one who makes his home in us. In Jesus, we have eternal life and we are called to love one another. The Gospels this week show us the public life of Jesus as it begins in **John**. Monday we hear John's iconic opening lines of his Gospel: “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.”
