**Sacrament of Reconciliation**  
 available from **1:30 to 2:30 p.m.**  
**Divine Mercy Chaplet at 3:00 p.m.,**  
 followed by **Benediction**

**How to pray the Chaplet of the Divine Mercy:**

- One Our Father, one Hail Mary and the Apostles' Creed prayed on the first three beads.
- On the first bead of each decade: *"Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world."*
- On the ten beads of each decade: *"For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and the whole world."*
- After 5 decades, the concluding doxology (three times): *"Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world."*

**Requirements for Plenary Indulgence for Divine Mercy Sunday:**

- Celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation 20 days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday.
- Receive Holy Communion of Divine Mercy Sunday.
- Pray for the intentions of **Pope Francis**.

(An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven.)

**OUR LADY OF FATIMA AND SSJ PARISH:**

For many decades, our parish has had a devotion to the **Blessed Mother**, under the title of **Our Lady of Fatima**. This **May 13**, the **Feast of Our Lady of Fatima**, marks the **100th** anniversary of the **Blessed Mother's** first apparition at **Fatima**. To mark this anniversary, I asked the **Women's Guild** to underwrite an embellishment of the statue of **Our Lady of Fatima** in the day chapel. **Mr. Todd Brausch** of **T. Brausch Studio** in **Lithopolis**, did the work on the statue, as well as painting the niches on either side of the portrait of **Our Lady of Guadalupe** in the rear of the church. In addition to painting the niches, he carved and gold leafed two Marian emblems that fill the niches. The painted scroll work in the niches is an adaptation of the decorations that adorn the mantle of the statue of **Our Lady of Fatima** in the day chapel.
