Half the proceeds of the CCC collection stay in our diocese for CTNY productions and broadcasts of diocesan events.

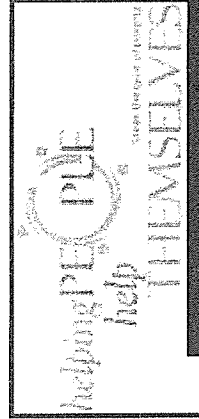
## CATHOLIC CAMPAIGN FOR HUMAN DEVELOPMENT

CCHD gives poor and low-income Americans hope to build a better life through self-help projects, giving community members a chance to work together to attack the root causes of poverty and injustice.

In our diocese, CCHD Grants of over \$1.3 million in the past 44 years have enabled poor and low-income people to make significant changes in their lives and communities. 25% of the collection stays locally.

CCHD projects have created affordable housing, helped save and create jobs, organized neighborhood anti-crime efforts, provided opportunities for community reinvestment, and helped families obtain credit.

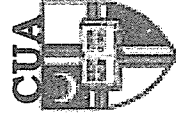
