Mother Teresa Shelter, Inc.

Incorporated on August 4, 2001 as a non-profit faith based organization, our doors opened to the public for the first time on September 23, 2003. As a day shelter we provide supportive services to homeless persons. The services provided are designed to help the community meet the needs and demands of our homeless population.

Services

We are a Day Shelter that identifies key characteristics of homelessness while providing individualized case management and counseling to facilitate movement to permanent independent living.

- ⇒ **FOOD** – Breakfast is served daily from 8:00 - 9:00 am. For registered clients, Brunch is served daily at 10:30 am and an afternoon snack is served at 2:00 pm.
- ⇒ **SHOWERS AND LAUNDRY** – clients can wash their clothes, take showers, and receive assistance with personal hygiene.
- ⇒ **CLOTHING AND SHOES** – each person receives a clean change of seasonally appropriate clothing and shoes.
- ⇒ **LOCKERS** – are made available for clients to store their personal belongings.
- ⇒ **PHONE AND INTERNET SERVICE** – to communicate with their families, relatives, or to search for job opportunities.
- ⇒ **DEVELOPMENTALLY APPROPRIATE PROGRAM AND CURRICULUM ARE READILY ACCESSIBLE** - i.e. reading, writing, art therapy, music therapy, horticultural gardening, and a computer lab, which includes e-mail and job search.
- ⇒ **SUPPORT GROUPS** - AA and Anger Management Support Groups are available.
- ⇒ **BUS TOKENS** – to help clients respond to various appointments on time.

Multipurpose Activity and Therapeutic Center

Mission:

Our mission is to effectively deliver holistic services in a collaborative effort following a community-centered approach.

Purpose:

To address the needs of the temporarily, episodic, and chronic homeless while incorporating activities that will foster learning and aid with the development of social skills using art as a medium through which innermost thoughts and feelings can be expressed. This while incorporating other mediums, such as music, horticultural gardening, exercise and sport, which are known to aid in insomnia, depression, and low self-esteem and other symptoms associated with living on the streets.

Mother Teresa Transitional Housing for Men

Our Transitional Housing program provides housing for 24 single men for a period not exceeding 24 months. Located at 1605 Mestina St., this community-based program combines transitional housing, and supportive services which are intended to create permanent housing and individual self-sufficiency.
