Traffic Notes

Please drop off your children after 7:30 AM on the 34th Avenue side of the school, NOT on the residential side on 33rd Avenue. Our neighbors have to be able to access their driveways at all times. Please let's be good neighbors and not double park/drop off on that side of the school.

When you drop off on 34th, please use the crosswalk and obey all regular traffic rules! Driving on the wrong side of the street, double parking, and telling your child to run across the street through traffic, even stopped traffic, is DANGEROUS to everyone around you, including your own child/ren.
