THE BOOK OF REMEMBRANCE FOR ALL SOULS WILL BE PRESENT AT THE SIDE ALTAR FROM TUESDAY EVENING, NOVEMBER 1, 2016 THROUGHOUT THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER. PLEASE FEEL FREE TO ENTER THE NAME (S) OF YOUR DEPARTED LOVED ONES SO THAT ALL PEOPLE WILL BE ABLE TO PRAY FOR THEM.

Since the Christmas Season will be upon us soon, plans are being made for all celebrations. In keeping with this planning, we will taking a "show of hands" vote on the time for the "Midnight Mass". You will be asked, at the Masses of November 12th & 13th, whether (by a show of hands) you would prefer a 10:00pm Mass or a 12:00 Midnight Mass for the late evening Mass. The 5:00pm Family Mass and the 10:00am Christmas Day Mass would remain the same.

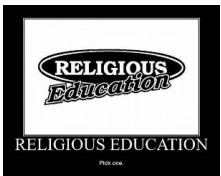
children attended classes last week. Best attendance ever. Thank you, parents for your commitment for your children.
