Church Regulations for Fasting and Abstinence during Lent:

Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to abstain from meat on all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. "Everyone 18 or older, and under 59 years of age, is bound to fast on Good Friday. "On Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not apply. *Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.

Word Among Us, A complete Catholic Mass and Daily Meditation Booklet will be available beginning on Ash Wednesday for you to pick up for your Lenten meditation and prayers. The booklets will be on the table at the front of the church, and will also be available in the Chapel.

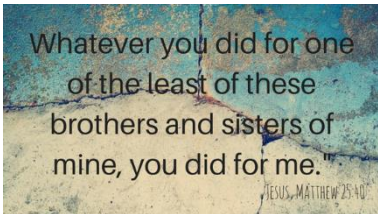

Please continue to support our local Lord's Pantry with non-perishable goods. The need for food is growing in our area. Meals on Wheels volunteers delivered 6,188 meals last year, and St. Ann volunteers delivered nearly 900 of those meals. In addition to this, donations from our parishioners of non-perishable foods are taken to the Food Pantry each Thursday, and St. Ann's gave out over \$700 in Food Vouchers to the poor and hungry. We have just been made aware that 267 children from the Lumberport Elementary School and of the Lincoln Middle School go hungry from Friday to Monday

when they cannot get a meal at school. One church is trying to send at least 4 items home for the 142 children from the Lumberport area, and St. Ann's will be attending a meeting to see how we can help the 125 children from Lincoln Middle that are going hungry. Updates will follow.
