Akila is appointed pastor of St. James the Apostle Parish in Clarksburg, St. Ann Parish in Shinnston, and Sacred Heart Mission in Salem with continued residence at the parish rectory in Clarksburg, effective June 20, 2018. Even though the notice does not state that St. Anns will have an Associate Pastor with residence at St. Ann's, I was told from the Diocese that St. Ann's will have an Associate Pastor from Sri Lanka, he is one of six priests coming from the Third Order Regular of St. Francis in Sr Lanka. The priest that comes to St. Ann's will maintain a residence at St. Anns. He should be coming to the diocese during the first part of June, and his formal date to begin at St. Ann's is June 20, 2018.
