EUCCHARIST MIRACLE: In 1996 when then Bishop Jorge Bergoglio (now Pope Francis) was an auxiliary bishop, the host had fallen on the ground, so it was placed in water to dissolve. Days later, the Eucharist wasn't dissolved at all—it had turned into bloody Flesh. In 1999 3 years later the same bloody Flesh remained. Dr. Castanon, a Bolivian neurophysiologist, was called and given sample. After testing he was told the samples constituted heart muscle, further the test showed the blood was human, the same as found on the Shroud of Turin. The host was taken to Dr Frederick Zugible and he tested the sample and stated that the sample was pulsating like a living, beating heart. When Dr. Castonaon first came across the miracle in 1999, he was an atheist. Today, he is a Catholic.
