

Exploring Liturgical Signs and Symbols within our Catholic Church: Laying on of hands is with many symbolic meanings. In the Old Testament, it was a form of blessing (Leviticus 1:4, 8:14) to signify something being offered or handed over to another. The Laying of the hands on the the bull to be sacrificed indicated its being handed over to God. Property and inheritance was also transferred from one person to another through this gesture (Genesis 27:27-29).

In the New Testament, laying on of hands is a gesture of blessing (Mark 10:16), of healing (Mark 6:5, 18:18, James 5:14), of imparting the Holy Spirit (Acts 8:15) and of church authority (Acts 6: 1-6). Today, the laying on of hands is part of the symbolism in the liturgies of Baptism, Confirmation, Holy Order

and the Anointing of the Sick. It is often used in other liturgies to symbolize a blessing being offered over another.
