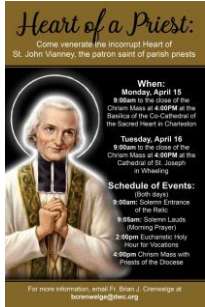
# LET US FIND OUR LOST SHEEP & LET US BUILD UP OUR PARISH



We are moving into the fifth week of Lent on April 5, 2019. The Liturgical Theme for that week is Compassion...The topic of the Presentation is To be a Christian means...The menu will feature Mexican Food, and the Stations of the Cross will follow dinner at approximately 6:45pm or 7:00pm



St. Ann Penance Service will be held on Thursday, April 4, 2019 at 7:00pm. Several priests from this area will be at the service to hear confessions. A soup supper will be served at 6:30pm before confessions.



The miraculously incorrupt heart of St. John Vianney, endearingly known as the “Cure of Ars” and the patron saint of parish priests, will be coming to our diocese during Monday and Tuesday of Holy Week (April 15 and 16). The relic will be in Charleston at the Basilica of the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart on Monday, April 15<sup>th</sup>, and the Cathedral of St. Joseph in Wheeling on Tuesday, April 16<sup>th</sup>. On both days, the relic will be available for veneration from 9am through to the completion of the Chrism Mass beginning at 4:00pm.

St. Ann’s Annual Easter Bake Sale will be held on Saturday, April 13 from 8:00am to 2:00pm. Breakfast will be available and the cost for Breakfast is \$6.00

The Holy Name Society will be hosting a Fritti Sale on April 27<sup>th</sup>. Frittis will be ready beginning at 8:00am. The cost is \$12.00 per dozen. Come and enjoy. They go fast.

St. Ann Altar Society will host the Spring Spaghetti Dinner on Sunday, April 28, 2019. Dinner will begin to be served directly after the 10:00am Mass at approximately 11:00am. Cost for the dinner is \$10.00 for adults, and \$5.00 for children.
