Please contact the Pastor at least 6 months prior to the proposed date of marriage.

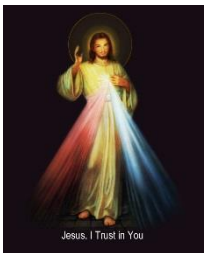

Next Sunday, April 28th, 2019 is Divine Mercy Sunday. Jesus gave instructions for the feast to St. Faustina, and she faithfully recorded them in her diary. He asked that "On the day of My feast, the Feast of Mercy, you will go through the whole world and bring fainting souls to the spring of My mercy. I shall heal and strengthen them." A novena is typically nine days of prayer in preparation of a feast day and is typically recited at 3:00pm each day. We will begin our Novena for Divine Mercy on Friday after stations of the cross and ask that you follow the novena on EWTN at 3:00pm each day on Saturday, thru Wed. The Novena will resume at St. Ann on Thursday and Friday at 5:30pm. We celebrate the feast day on Sunday. Pamphlets are available in the Church for your prayers.
