She was received into the Catholic Church in 1922, and entered the Carmelite Order in Cologne in 1923. At the end of 1939, she moved to the convent in Echt on account of the Nazi persecution of Jews, and in 1942, during the Nazi occupation of Holland, she was arrested, transported to Poland, and killed at Auschwitz. August 6th and 9th are the anniversaries of the atomic explosions over Hiroshima and Nagasaki in 1945. During this time of such unrest in the world, let us pray through the intercession of St. Teresa Benedicta that a true and lasting peace may be realized throughout the world.
