ARCHBISHOP'S CALL TO SHARE



Congratulations to both parishes for surpassing the target goal, and I share my gratitude as well as Archbishop Naumann's for your generosity! As of last Wednesday, there were responses from 54% of the St. Boniface parishioners (59 families), who have pledged \$7,159.00, or 104% of the target, with an average gift of \$121.00. There were responses from 67% of the St. Therese parishioners (31 families), who have pledged \$6,530.00, or 200% of the target, with an average gift of \$211.00. The official close of Call to Share 2015 is very near! I will make one final submission of pledges to

the Archdiocese - so if you have not done so already, and wish to make a pledge or a gift this year, please do so by Sunday, March 22nd at the latest. There are pledge envelopes on the tables at the entrance of each church. Thank you!

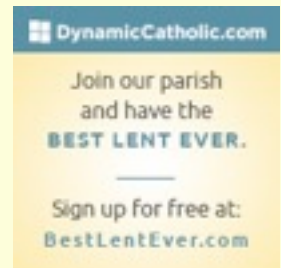
