If you believe a child is in immediate danger, call 911 and law enforcement. In addition to making a report to the proper civil authorities, if your allegation, suspicion or concern involves a church volunteer, employee or member of the clergy or religious, please also make a report to the Archdiocese Report Investigator, Jan Saylor, at the confidential number: 913.647.3051 or by submitting an online report at: <http://www.archkck.org/reportabuse>.
