HOLIDAY FOOD COLLECTION - bins have been placed at the entrance of each church for the collection of non-perishable food items, and will remain in place until Christmas. We will make a delivery to local food pantries shortly before Thanksgiving, and again, just before Christmas. Thanks so much for participating in this corporal work of mercy!
