The following information comes from the figures of those pledges that have been made and processed through our parish office as of Monday, February 19th: **St. Therese:** \$2,530.00 pledged (98.02% of target), by 14 individuals (35% of parishioners), with an average gift of \$180.71. **St. Boniface:** \$4,115.00 pledged (79.7% of target), by 26 individuals (25.7% of parishioners), with an average gift of \$158.27.
