A Walk Through the Year With Our Pilgrims Calendar Fundraiser

We are blessed to have active youth in our parish - this means to say that our Church has a future. The youth are essential members of our Church. Some of you may not be aware that these youth have been so involved in a lot of different ministries in our parish such as during our Vacation Bible School wherein they get to work with our small children. They serve as facilitators, serve as lectors, altar servers, Eucharistic ministers, Children's Liturgy, servers during parish fundraising events, Parish festival volunteers. And also they are leaders in their respective schools.

This calendar fundraiser is for our Youth Pilgrimage in July to different Holy sites such as Lourdes, Assisi, Rome and Vatican City. On the pilgrimage, we have 2 priests, a deacon, 13 youth pilgrims and their chaperones

To donate to this Calendar fundraiser:

Pick a special date on the calendar when you would like to offer a Mass intention. For example, a birthday, wedding anniversary, requiem mass or death anniversary of a loved one, or feast day of a favorite Saint.

Donate the amount for that day: January 1st is \$1, January 2nd is \$2, January 3rd is \$3, but it's past those dates already. So we begin on Monday, January 22nd is \$22, February 1st is \$32, February 2nd is \$33 all the way to December 31st is \$365.

Keep in mind that this is different from our usual Mass intentions that go to our parish funds. This calendar fundraiser has been used in other parishes and it's been very effective such as in St. Mary's Church in Vacaville. We do hope that you support our Youth in our parish.

Pilgrims will be in the vestibule after masses to take your generous donations.

Some concerns or questions: Is this worth investing? Why am I paying for vacations of families or youth going to this trip? I'll just save up money for myself?

Answer: Take note, **this is NOT A VACATION...IT'S A PILGRIMAGE!** A pilgrimage is a spiritual journey to enrich one's spirituality, to personally witness the richness of our faith and tradition. By going on a pilgrimage, we widen our horizons in understanding, treasuring, cherishing our faith and tradition. In a lot of ways, it's an encounter with the Lord and thus a life-changing experience.

In the process of raising funds, our youth are being formed to be responsible individuals as they are being mindful of their responsibilities, to value hard work and give priority to their spiritual and communal life as they busy their lives with our church events.

One thing that needs to be clarified is that the parish is not paying the whole amount for the chaperones. They have their own share of paying the cost of their trip. They do help raise funds as well in support of our youth. **So this is not a free trip for everyone except for the 2 priests** (Fr. Julito and Fr. Eric Flores from Sacred Heart Parish, Anderson).

We appeal to you that you do what you can to help fund this noble cause for our youth just like what you did for the 7 pilgrims that went to the World Youth Day 2 years ago. The opportunity to support is always available since we do have variety of fundraiser activities throughout the year. You may also want to consider sponsoring a youth. **Any monetary support you can give is greatly appreciated. God bless your generosity.**

The Gabriel Project Needs You!

Many women faced with crisis pregnancies are abandoned by their families, the father of their babies and their communities. More and more, they face poverty mostly being in their teens. Some are homeless; most feel afraid. For too many reasons, abortion seems the only answer. Churches and pro-life service groups have sought ways to expand their embrace of pregnant women in crisis.

The Gabriel Project is a church based outreach whose volunteers offer assistance to women and families facing difficult or crisis pregnancies. "Sign of Hope" will be placed in the bulletin board which includes the "800" helpline number. By calling to this number, any woman will receive immediate and practical help from the local prepared Christian community and coordinator. The coordinator and the Church volunteers- "Angels" work with local community resources to meet the mother's needs.

El Proyecto Gabriel lo Necesita!

En varia circunstancias las mujeres que afrontan un embarazo no planeado son abandonadas por sus familias, los padres de sus bebes y sus comunidades. Aun siendo tan jovenes, comienzan a enfrenar la pobreza. Sienten miedo al no tener el apoyo necesario al quedarse sin hogar. Por muchas razones, el aborto parece ser su unica respuesta. A travez del Proyecto Gabriel tendremos una forma especial de combinar el poder de la oracion con el compromiso de servir.

El Proyecto Gabriel es un proyecto en cual voluntarios de la Iglesia tienen el compromiso de ofrecer asistencia a las mujeres y familias afrontando embarazos dificiles. Un folleto "Signo de Esperanza" sera colocado con su numero de asistencia. Al hablar a la "Linea de Ayuda", las mujeres seran dirigidas a los coordinadores de la Iglesia mas sercana. El coordinador y los voluntarios "Los Angeles" colaboran con recursos de su comunidad para ofrecer las ayudas necesarias a las necesidades de la madre.
