Jeanne called the meeting to order. Bob led the opening prayer.

Gordon is attending the Beer Garden Meetings, and he is a member of the Church Maintenance Committee. He briefed the committee that research is being done on the electrical needs pertaining to the Beer Garden that will take place Sept. 22. He added that the planning for that event was progressing well.

Jeanne will check with Hurley Portables to ensure that the Port-A-Pots and sink will be serviced after the Beer Garden and made ready for our picnic guests.

Bob is pricing industrial fan prices.

A question arose about money handling at the Beer Garden. Jeanne will check with the church accountant about this concern.

The dining room will welcome guests to enter and feast from 10:30 to 2:30. At 2:15 an announcement will be made that the dining room will close in 15 minutes. This committee suggests that all remaining food items from our dinner be sold at the Carry Out at pre-set prices.

After more discussion the meeting ended. Our next gathering will be at 6:30 on August 3.

August 3, 2017 Minutes of Picnic Committee

All members were present for this meeting. Jerry and Jean Baker, Joanne Kochert, Becky McCoy, and Donna Newton were also in attendance. Donna led the opening prayer.

A need to enlarge the area used by the Nickel Pitch was stated, and a desire for a possibly larger Silent Auction tent was mentioned. A discussion of booth rearrangement began. Suggestions were made. The committee tabled these issues when Bob agreed to meet with Bernie Gettelfinger to work on possible layouts.

Jeanne informed the committee that a gun has been donated for our raffle this year. It is a 12 gauge Remington 870 Express with an aluminum case.

Jeanne has been working to finalize the printing of the raffle tickets. She presented some raffle ticket proofs for editing. The tickets will soon be available for distribution.

Parishioners will be asked to donate three cakes instead of two for the Cake Booth this year since the booth ran out of cakes earlier than they wished to last year.

Jo reported that 15 hardworking individuals worked Saturday, August 5 cooking and chopping 240 pounds of chicken and making 57 buckets of broth. This endeavor was headed by Jerry Baker. Jo proudly reported that the dumpling making, chicken cooking, and broth making processes are nearing completion. The committee thanks all who worked these events so far, and warns that your chance to contribute and be a part of these processes is running out. The last dumpling making session is scheduled to take place Saturday, August 12. Then the final bagging of these dumplings will take place after the 8:00 AM mass on September 3!

Bob stated that some Banners are being purchased. He reported that Pop-A-Shot, a basketball booth, will be present at the picnic.

Bob was asked to contact Horner Novelty's and order the needed small prizes that are used at several booths.

Some of the North Harrison FFA Members agreed to work the Pedal Tractor Pull for 2017. Next year the committee believes that the Pedal Tractor Pull will be replaced by a Talent Show.

Jo stated that St. Michael's will be able to use a large raffle drum from Mt. St. Francis this year and that St. Michael's was given permission to put up the large sign advertising our picnic there near the entrance along State Road 150.

It was decided by the committee to have a meeting every Thursday until Picnic Day. **All Chairpersons are asked and encouraged to attend a Picnic Chairpersons Meeting on Thursday, August 17. This meeting will be held in the church basement, and it will begin at 6:30 PM.**
