**Tax Tip** Since this is tax season, here's a tip for those with a tax deferred retirement account such as an IRA, 401K, etc. Once you reach 70 ½, you'll be required to start taking Required Minimum Distributions (RMD) which are taxed. You can reduce your tax liability with charitable contributions, including those to your church, if they are done as a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). This is not an itemized deduction. For information as to how to make these, consult the trustee handling your retirement account or your tax adviser. If you still have questions, contact the parish office and we'll have someone try to help you.


