VBS Roar at a Glance:

Monday – On Monday we learned  
that when Life is not fair – God is  
Good! In Bible Stories we heard  
about how the Israelites were  
enslaved in Egypt but God was

Moses. We learned our theme  
song in Music, played with a  
tumble drum in imagination  
station, and in Missions we learned  
about a young boy named, Gift who  
traveled to school and listened to  
his teacher on a radio.
