This week-October 8, 2017 Browsing in Solomon's Library
The book of Proverbs begins with Solomon's name, as someone who epitomized ancient wisdom. But this book is grounded in a larger world outside ancient Israel, and reacts to that non-Israelite world. There were other collections of proverbs, and even other Jobs who suffered outside Israel, and browsing these other texts helps us understand the biblical books of Proverbs, Job and Ecclesiastes. **Professor Sam Meier** received his Ph.D. from Harvard University (1987) in Hebrew and Semitic Languages and Literatures. He began teaching at the Ohio State University in 1986 in the Department of Near Eastern Languages and Cultures.
