APPLICATION PROCESS SUMMARY PAGE FOR NEW STUDENTS

Thank you for your interest in attending St. John Paul II High School. The St. JPII H.S. application and tuition assistance deadline for new students is March 31, 2019; however, applications may be accepted, and assistance available after said date if space and funds are available. The tuition is \$6,400, however this does not cover the cost per student incurred by the school. The school makes up the substantial difference by annual fundraising activities by our families and their 25 parent participation hours, along with grants, and its endowment. The family PTO fundraising requirement ranges from \$400 or \$575 depending on the level of tuition assistance granted. Fundraising for individual teams and clubs at the school does not apply to a family's school fundraising obligation, however items donated to teams and clubs may apply toward their required 25 parent participation hours at a credit of \$10 an hour with receipt. A 10% reduction in tuition is granted for each child if the family has more than one child at BGMPS or St. JPIIHS.

STEP 2: Apply for Financial Aid (only if needed) Application process open in December 2018

St. John Paul II High School uses an independent third party, FACTS Tuition Aid Assessment, to determine eligibility for financial assistance. Tuition assistance may be provided to those with need who qualify on a first-come, first-serve basis, keeping in mind that tuition assistance funds are limited. **Submission of a FACTS Tuition Aid application and the school's reception and review is <u>mandatory</u> in order for anyone to be considered for tuition assistance. There is a FACTS Application Fee of \$30.00. A link to the FACTS Aid Application can be found on our website under the admissions area.**

If you need assistance while applying for aid or desire to check your status, you may call the Registrar at 361 855-5744, Ext 202. For those seeking tuition assistance, please apply as soon as possible. The review process can take 2 weeks to complete <u>AFTER</u> all required documents have been submitted.

STEP 3: Parent Tuition Agreement & Student Interview

Once the necessary application documents have been submitted an interview is scheduled. During the interview time, the parent(s) will meet with an administrator to finalize the tuition agreement and the student will be interviewed. If the student is accepted the parent will then be able to complete the enrollment process online and the student will schedule their placement test date.
