Effective Date: April 1, 2014


Purpose – St. Ignatius Loyola Catholic Community is blessed with a beautiful church and related facilities and grounds. The Parish is also blessed with many ministries and volunteer organizations that make invaluable contributions to our catholic community, our area, and beyond. Many of these organizations advertise their activities by placing banner, wooden, or other types of signs on church grounds on Cypresswood Drive and Squyres Road. In order to preserve the beauty of Parish facilities and grounds, while balancing the need for appropriate advertising of Parish ministries, volunteer organizations, events, etc., our Church has electronic signs on the Christus Center building and on Cypresswood Drive available for use.

The following policy applies:


- 1) Electronic signs are available for use to post rotating messages or notices. Please submit all requests to the Parish Administrator via email to parishadministrator@silcc.org for review and approval.
- 2) With limited exceptions, banner, wooden, or other types of signs on church grounds are not allowed. After April 1, 2014, any signs that have not been approved by the Parish Administrator are subject to being removed. The Parish will not be responsible for unauthorized signs that are removed.


