## Important Information



### Drop Off Procedure Reminder – PLEASE READ

All traffic must enter through the Marshall Avenue entrance. Upon entering, drivers may choose to go the left side or the right side of the school annex, or you may park in middle parking spaces and accompany your child to the breezeway door. Below is the PROPER procedure for dropping of kids.

- 1) Those choosing the right (playground) side should drop their children off at the breeze way doors. If possible those children should exit the car on the left side toward the building. If they exit on the right, the children should walk in front of their own car and not behind. After the children are safely to the building the driver may proceed ahead and exit onto North Sherwood and turn right. **They must not make a U-turn!**
- 2) Those choosing the left (Church) side of the Annex should drop their children off at the breeze way doors. If possible those children should exit the car on the right side toward the building. If they exit on the left, the children should walk in front of their own car and not behind. After the children are safely to the building the driver should then carefully make a U-turn toward the left and exit back onto Marshall Avenue. **DO NOT CROSS over to the right side of the annex to exit and DO NOT exit out the front entrance.**
- 3) Parents wishing to accompany their children into the building in the morning are encouraged to use the parking spaces in middle of parking lot, **DO NOT PARK BY THE ANNEX.**

**These procedures are put into place for the safety of the children and the drivers. I ask that for the safety of all; please follow the procedures that have been put into place! Thank you.**

REMEMBER, WE ARE ON OUR OWN AND YOU NEED TO LOOK FOR ST. ANTHONY SCHOOL. If we are on a delay, both Pre-School and St. Anthony School will open to students at 8:00 AM.

## Health Tip

The single best way to prevent seasonal flu is to get vaccinated each year, but good health habits like covering your cough and washing your hands often can help stop the spread of germs and prevent respiratory illnesses like the flu. The tips and resources below will help you learn about steps you can take to protect yourself and others from flu and help stop the spread of germs.

- **Avoid close contact.**  
Avoid close contact with people who are sick. When you are sick, keep your distance from others to protect them from getting sick too.
- **Stay home when you are sick.**  
If possible, stay home from work, school, and errands when you are sick. This will help prevent spreading your illness to others.
- **Cover your mouth and nose.**  
Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when coughing or sneezing. It may prevent those around you from getting sick. Flu and other serious respiratory illnesses, like respiratory syncytial virus (RSV), whooping cough, and severe acute respiratory syndrome (SARS), are spread by cough, sneezing, or unclean hands.
- **Clean your hands.**  
Washing your hands often will help protect you from germs. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand rub.

1. 2nd Quarter Service Hour Reporting
