## **This Friday is.... Stewardship Friday!**

All Grades will have Stewardship Friday on February 8th. Your G.I.F.T.S For God envelope is in today's Wednesday Notes folder.

Here is what we will cover:

- Kindergartener's will learn that: 1) our families are a blessing from God; 2) not all children have families; and 3) children without families are sometimes adopted by loving families.
- 1st Grader's will learn that: 1) we have neighbors who are in need in other parts of the world; and 2) neighbors in need can still be happy. Don't forget to send in their decorated shoe box and a gently used pair of shoes you no longer need. We are donating the shoes to needy families.
- 2nd Grader's - will understand the difference between meeting the immediate needs of our neighbors who are hungry and helping them build a better future for themselves and their families.
- 3rd Grader's – will learn that young children and people who are elderly can have special friendships.
- 4th Grader's will understand what it might feel like to have a learning difference.
- 5th Grader's – will learn about the Stewardship Virtue of integrity and why it is important for Christians to live lives of integrity.
- 6th Grader's – will hear from speakers about their foster care and adoption experiences. Students will learn about foster and/or adoptive parenting, why it is important, why people choose it, what some of the challenges may be, and what the positive aspects are.
- 7th Grader's – After watching videos about the daily the typical day of 3 homeless people the students will understand some of the struggles and obstacles of neighbors who are homeless and the ways that people help them.
- 8th Graders - After the "The Dr. Faith Talk Show", the students will understand the role the Stewardship Virtue of FAITH and how to write a Personal Mission Statement.

Parents, over the weekend follow up with your child about their Stewardship Friday experience. They will bring home information about their activities.

## **Stewardship Minimum Requirement Update**

If you are a registered parish school family and desire a St. Anthony Stewardship Scholarship for next year be sure you meet the minimum requirements by March 31, 2019.

1. **Service Hours** - You need 24 service hours. The final quarter report is due at the end of March.

2. **Mass Attendance** - You need 26 Weekend Mass attendances from April 1, 2018 to March 31, 2019. There are 9 weekends in February & March to get to the 26-minimum requirement.
