This year's focus surrounds the Sanctity of Human Life Sunday, a day to celebrate the intrinsic value of all human life.



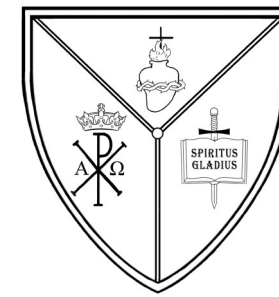
