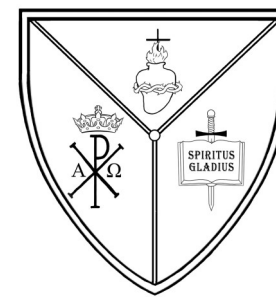

Diocesan / Parish Share Campaign 2019

Our goals this year are:

St. Paul: \$35,016

Christ the King \$39,650

Sacred Heart: \$20,197

The goal amounts at St. Paul and Christ the King have been reduced from last year's goals. Still, these are the amounts that we must pay to the Diocese. Anything over this amount is returned to us, free from any assessment by the Diocese.

This year, you will receive mailings directly from the Diocese, instead of receiving a letter from me. When the chancery offices were reorganized last year, so was the DPSC process. This past week, I met with the Director of Development for the Diocese to learn about the new DPSC procedure. Instead of the DPSC work happening in our parish offices, all households will be mailed a letter from the Bishop, and the responses will be given directly to the Bishop's office. The dinners have been abolished as well. Instead, the Bishop will be doing parish visitations, where you will have a chance to personally interact with him.

The campaign will officially begin the weekend of March 23.

What are we going to do with any refund that we receive?

This year, we hope to use the St. Paul refund to work on the electrical problems that we have in the church.

At Christ the King, we hope to use the refund money to refurbish another section of the parking lot, taking up the old asphalt and replacing it with concrete.

At Sacred Heart, we hope for a refund to work on the crumbling stained glass window frames on the front of the church.

Every donation is important and helps us achieve our goal and receive a refund. Because we do not have typical parish fund raisers like raffles or bingo, this yearly drive helps us to do maintenance work that would otherwise require a special collection. Please consider helping in this annual appeal. Thank you!
