Thank you so much for your time & effort in putting this together as it is greatly appreciated. Terry was proud to be a member of Christ the King parish.

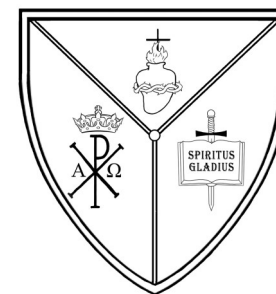

2019 Diocesan / Parish Share Campaign Update

As of this past Tuesday, April 16:

Parishioners of St. Paul have pledged \$17,425.00 toward our goal of \$35,016.00.

Parishioners of Sacred Heart have pledged \$3,550.00 to our goal of \$20,197.00.

Parishioners of Christ the King have pledged \$10,165.00 toward our goal of \$39,650.00.

This is a great start! If you would like to make a pledge, there are envelopes in the pews at the churches. You can also go online to diosteub.org and click the "Give Online" button.

"How does this campaign work?" Each parish is given a financial goal that we must pay to the Diocese. Parishioners pledge money in this campaign to help the parish make the goal.

"What happens if our pledges do not cover this goal?" If we do not make our goal in pledge payments, the parish has to make up the deficit from our Sunday collections. Our regular Sunday collections go to pay priests, staff, and all of the parishes' bills. We run tight weekly budgets in our parishes, so any campaign payments coming from our Sunday collections would put us quickly into debt.

"What happens if we go over our goal?" That money is returned to our parish, free from any diocesan tax. The diocese places a tax on our yearly income, and we pay that tax in monthly installments. This campaign was designed to keep the diocesan tax percentage on parish income low, while giving parishes an opportunity to raise funds for special projects.

"I don't want to give money to the Diocese." All I can tell you is that your contribution helps the parish first, and that the money from this campaign goes to support various services we have at the parish level. For example, our parishes currently have seven annulment cases at the tribunal, and we have been working with the office of Catholic Charities on several initiatives to help local farmers and those who are impoverished in our area. These are some of the ways that our parishioners and community are helped by the Diocesan offices that may not be visible to us.

Every contribution to this campaign is important and helps us to make our goal. Thank you for your consideration and generosity!
