**ROSARY** - During May, the Rosary will be prayed 20 minutes prior to weekend Masses at CTK & immediately following weekend Masses at STP.




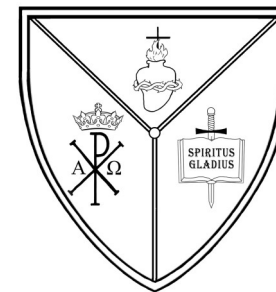
