In today's gospel, we do not have just another healing story among others. In this Canaanite woman who follows after Jesus with her cries, the disciples seem to see only a nuisance to be silenced by sending her away after granting her request. The Canaanite woman's attitude resembles Mary's. She thinks only of her daughter, "tormented by a demon." She knows Jesus can cure her. The way she addresses Jesus is remarkable.
