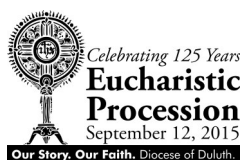

I was ordained a priest of the Diocese of Duluth in June of 2009. I spent my first three years of priesthood in Brainerd as the associate pastor of Brainerd Area Catholic Churches.
