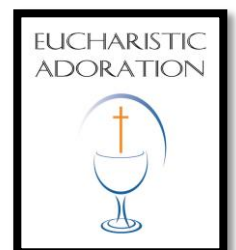
Year of the Eucharist

We have now begun our special “Year of the Eucharist”. We are being invited by God to enter more deeply into the mystery of Jesus, truly present among us in the Most Blessed Sacrament. To help facilitate a deeper devotion to Jesus in the Eucharist there will be a “cool quote” included in the bulletin each week from the saints about our belief in the Eucharistic presence of Jesus like the one above from St. Alphonsus de Ligouri.

In addition to the cool quote, Fr. David is leading a special **Holy Hour of Adoration** each Sunday afternoon at 3:00pm at St. Patrick’s in Havana. During this time Fr. David and the Holy Spirit will teach you how to pray more deeply and you will experience a deeper peace in your soul as well as a deeper union with God. Please arrange your schedule to come as often as you can and witness the transformation of your own heart in Christ Jesus.



Summer Bible Study: Further, Fr. David will be leading a summer bible study on the Eucharist. We will begin by studying the 6th chapter of St. John’s Gospel. It will be held at **St. Patrick’s in Havana at 7-8pm on Thursdays** beginning this Thursday (June 14th). Through this study, you will gain a much deeper knowledge and understanding of the gift and mystery of the Holy Eucharist.
