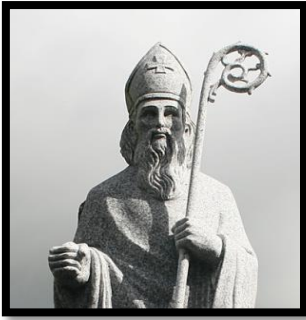

Year of the Eucharist

Fr. David is leading a special **Holy Hour of Adoration** each **Sunday afternoon at 3:00pm at St. Patrick’s in Havana**. During this time Fr. David and the Holy Spirit will teach you how to pray more deeply and you will experience a deeper peace in your soul as well as a deeper union with God. Please come as often as you can. Peace to you all.

HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION: This week we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary (body and soul) into the glory of heaven. All Catholics are *required* to attend Mass. It is a *mortal sin* not to attend Mass. The Mass schedule is as follows:

Tuesday, August 14th – Mass at Immaculate Conception at 6:00pm

Wednesday, August 15th – Mass at St. Mary’s at 7:30am and Mass at St. Patrick’s at 6:00pm

ST. MICHAEL’S LENT: Each year St. Francis of Assisi (in addition to the normal Lent observed by Catholics in the spring) observed a “*second Lent*” to grow in greater personal holiness. This “St. Michael’s Lent” begins on **August 16th** (after the Assumption of Mary) and ends on **September 29th** (the Feast of St. Michael the Archangel). I would like to encourage everyone to consider observing “St. Michael’s Lent” by incorporating *more prayer and penance* into your lives during this time. Since it is the Year of the Eucharist, *perhaps you could attend more Masses or more adoration than you normally do.*

1. Porcelain tile and marble flooring in the Sanctuary (around \$19,000.00)
2. Porcelain tile flooring, new counter tops and paint in the Sacristy (around \$8000.00)

4. New wood ceiling (TBA)
5. Refinishing the wood pews (TBA)
