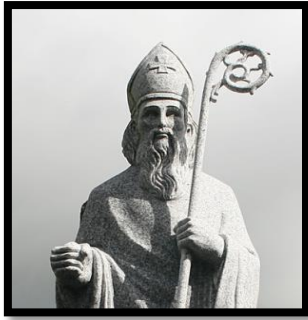

PLEASE JOIN US: September 15th, & 16th to hear Rev. Msgr. James McLoughlin speak about a ministry providing direct relief to the poor throughout Latin America and the Caribbean. Msgr. McLoughlin will share personal witness about *Food for the Poor's mission to care for the destitute as a means of living out the Gospel mandate to love one another*. Msgr. McLoughlin was ordained in 1965 for the Diocese of Rockford. Before retiring & joining Food for the Poor, he has served as Associate Pastor, Teacher at Madonna Catholic School, as a Pastor in many parishes & as Dean of Clergy.

4. New wood ceiling (TBA)
5. Refinishing the wood pews (TBA)
