A BRIEF HISTORY OF SACRED HEART CATHOLIC CHURCH

Spanish missionaries already served the Nacogdoches area as early as 1716, but the Right Reverend John M. Odin, D.D. established the first parish of Sacred Heart in 1847 with funds raised by Father A. Chanrion. This wooden structure stood for ninety years on North Pecan Street.

Through funds provided by Mr. and Mrs. J. H. Phelan and property donated by Mrs. C. C. (Louise) Rhein, Father Francis P. Crane had a new church building constructed on the corner of North Street and Mimms Avenue in April of 1936.

On April 26, 1937, carpenters dismantled the old Sacred Heart Church building on Pecan Street. They transported the lumber ten miles down the Old Lufkin Road to Fern Lake for the construction of St. Ann's Chapel. St. Ann's was completed on June 16, 1937, and it was consecrated by the Most Reverend Christopher E. Byrne. The church building was moved to Center, Texas in 1951, where it served as a chapel until 1983. The old building is now located on the grounds of Sacred Heart in Nacogdoches and has been restored.

In 1985, the Most Reverend Bernard J. Ganter, D.D., approved the purchase of land for the current church building. Under the leadership of Reverend James E. Young, the dream of a new parish church building became a reality. A groundbreaking ceremony was held on March 17, 1991. The building was completed in 1992, and a dedication Mass was held on June 26, 1992. The present Sacred Heart Catholic Church is located at 2508 Appleby Sand Road in Nacogdoches, Texas.

Dear Members of Sacred Heart Parish Family:

As some of you no doubt have heard, I have recently made the difficult decision to release Sacred Heart from the Boy Scout Charter associated with our parish for over thirty years. Troop 100 will remain with their number intact.

Let me first say that this was not a decision I made lightly, nor was it one that I made alone. I met with most of the scout leadership last August regarding the use of facilities, sought input from our Vicar General and advice from Bishop Strickland and it became clear to me that this was the best direction in which to move our parish in this new millennium.

One of the principle factors that caused me to explore moving in this direction was a simple matter of math. As our parish family continues to grow and thrive we are beginning to run out of space. Over the last several months, it had become very clear to me that several parish groups and organizations were not able to function properly or at times convenient to the greatest number possible because of the Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts were using so many of our rooms and/or venues.

Additionally, I became aware that an organization that was once established as a Catholic Pack and Troop is now comprised of many former scouts of other packs and troops for political and moral reasons. The Boy Scouts of America is a fine American institution with a rich history in our communities all over our country and continues the work of forming boys in that model.

Taking all these facts into consideration, the best course of action would be to release the charter associated with our parish, so that the scouting leadership can find a more suitable home and still keep Pack & Troop number -100. In the meantime, the scouts understand that they are welcome to use our facilities through the end of this school year. In addition our gym and amphitheatre are available for the foreseeable future as we strive to be good neighbors to all the boys of our Nacogdoches community and I encourage all other Churches and civic organizations to support Pack & Troop 100.

The Catholic Church has a very long and proud history of supporting and championing the civic, spiritual and moral values that are the hallmarks of the Boy Scouts of America. The Catholic aspects of scouting life for those boys, who are members of our parish, I hope, will continue with their Catholic spiritual development of weekly Mass attendance, Scout Sunday and the Ad Altare Dei program. I will continue to support them and ask you to do the same.

Los Boy Scouts of América es una excelente institución americana con una rica historia en nuestras comunidades de todo el país y continúa el trabajo de formar niños en ese modelo.
