Extraordinary ministers are needed to visit nursing centers, hospitals, and homes. Often times, it is stated if I were asked I would help. We are now asking you.

Priests and deacons cannot do it by themselves. Would you like to help? The Priest/Office needs to be informed of family members in the hospital, nursing center or at home unable to attend Church. Do not wait until your family member or friend is dying before calling us. We are all the Body of Christ.

As Saint Mother Teresa of Calcutta said, "How do we love? Not in big things but in small things with great love."
