CONFIRMATION: Has been scheduled for members of our parishes who are in grades 7-12, 2018 for Sunday, October 28, 2018. In order to prepare our youth for this final Sacrament of Initiation, there are some steps we will have to take. We will have an informational meeting, 11 weeks of classes, and one weekend retreat. Our informational meeting will be Sunday, June 24th, after the 10:30 a.m. Mass in the PCC. This meeting is for both children who will be receiving their confirmation (Confirmandi) and their parents. We will discuss the outline of the classes, expectations of behavior, retreat information, and address any questions or concerns you may have. At this meeting, we will need to have your emergency medical forms turned in, and whether your child will be attending the retreat in October.

CONGRATULATIONS to Emily Vigue, a graduate of St. Rose School, and Fisher Catholic High School who earned the outstanding student award from Marietta College's department of modern languages. She is studying international leadership and political science, and is set to graduate May 2019.

FISHER CATHOLIC: Takes second place in the Mid State League Cardinal Division Track Championships recently. Junior, Elizabeth Vigue set a league record in the shot put with a heave of 35'-6.75 ". She also placed 5th in the discus with a throw of 81'-10". Vigue's shot put throw beat the league mark set last year by almost two feet. Also contributing to the Fisher cause was freshman Abby Krile, who cleared 6' in the pole vault which earned her 4th place. Abby also ran the first leg of the 4x100 relay, which finished second in the event with a time of 54.79. Maeve Boley finished 10th in the shot put, her best throw was 22'8". In the high jump she placed 8th clearing jump of 4'. On the boy's side, junior Gavin LeGrand ran the first leg of the 4 x 400, which placed third, the first leg of the 4x200, which placed second and he ran the second leg of the 4 x 800, which took the event with a time of 8:46.99. All four are high honor roll students at Fisher Catholic High School. Elizabeth and Gavin have both qualified for the Regionals. We are very proud of all of you! May you have continued good luck!
