Dear Consortium Family,

As you have likely heard already, I have been reassigned to St. Joseph Cathedral in downtown Columbus. While I am quite sad to be leaving, I do in many ways look forward to the challenges ahead. My successor will be **Fr. Michael Hartge**. He is an exemplary priest and a fellow Carolian. He will begin his six-year term as pastor on **Tuesday, July 10th**. I know that he will serve the communities of the Consortium with excellence. So that Fr. Hartge might be able to assess and address the needs of the Consortium without being artificially restricted by decisions I made, I have decided to cancel several Mass and Confession times. The weekday, Saturday **morning**, and Sunday Confessions are canceled. Change is always difficult and the Consortium has seen more than its fair share in recent years, but faith, prayer, perseverance, and trust in God will see great fruit born in our lives and in our communities.

BE EXTRAORDINARY – SPECIAL MASS, SUNDAY THE 24TH

*Due to frequent requests by many parishioners, what is termed The Extraordinary Form of the Roman Rite will be offered at **St. Rose on Sunday, June 24th at 1:30 p.m.** This form of the Mass is sometimes called the Tridentine Mass, the Traditional Latin Mass (TLM), Usus Antiquior, or the old rite, but in 1962, it was simply called Mass. The Mass on the 24th will be what is called a Low Mass. This is a form of the Mass which has no singing and is largely very quiet, which invites participation by silent prayer. The Mass is offered entirely in Latin and with the priest facing the same direction as the people. No other Masses for the weekend of the 23rd/24th will be removed or changed for this special Mass. This Mass, however, **does count** for the Sunday obligation. Yours in Christ,*
