BE EXTRAORDINARY – ATTEND THE SPECIAL MASS, SUNDAY, June 24th

*Due to frequent requests by many parishioners, what is termed The Extraordinary Form of the Roman Rite will be offered at **St. Rose on Sunday, June 24th at 1:30 p.m.** This form of the Mass is sometimes called the Tridentate Mass, the Traditional Latin Mass (TLM), Uses Antiquary, or the old rite, but in 1962, it was simply called Mass. The Mass on the 24th will be what is called a Low Mass. This is a form of the Mass which has no singing and is largely very quiet, which invites participation by silent prayer. The Mass is offered entirely in Latin and with the priest facing the same direction as the people. No other Masses for the weekend of the 23rd/24th will be removed or changed for this special Mass. This Mass, however, **does count** for the Sunday obligation.*

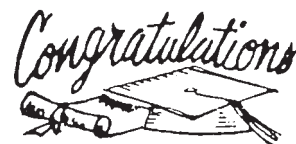
