FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

I must express my heartfelt gratitude to all who made last weekend's Installation Mass and reception such a beautiful success. It takes a lot to coordinate a Mass like that from all the ministers and servers to the well-rehearsed choir and the 4th degree Knights of Columbus. The reception was relaxed and joyful and the food prepared was delicious. We truly showed Bishop Campbell warm Perry County hospitality, and he appeared relaxed and to be enjoying himself... even if we embarrassed him a little with his birthday. I don't want to leave any names out of people who helped, so I'll leave them all out! :) Most sincerely, thank you!

On Monday, August 6, we celebrate the Feast of the **Transfiguration of the Lord**. It celebrates a familiar and descriptive account of Jesus taking Peter, James and John up a high mountain. Traditionally, this is Mount Tabor in Galilee and it is truly a HIGH mountain with a steep climb. Jesus appears in dazzling white clothes with Moses and Elijah beside Him representing his union with the Law and the Prophets, and indeed the foreshadowing of fulfilling them with His Passion, Death and Resurrection.

We then hear those important words, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him." When we pray, do we take time to listen to God? We can tell Him what we need, and who we'd like to pray for, but let us not forget to listen to what God is trying to tell us. This is easily done in the calming presence of the Blessed Sacrament. We can bring anything to the Lord, and then just take some time to sit quietly in His presence.

Incidentally, when Jesus is exposed in the Blessed Sacrament for Eucharistic Adoration (every Wednesday at 5:15 p.m. at St. Rose), we place the monstrance containing the host on a stand called a Tabor. Let us frequently approach Jesus in the Eucharist in prayer, and heed those words, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him." In doing so, we will surely find peace, answers to our prayers and questions, and strength to go forth proclaiming His lordship over our lives.
