FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

As we well know, every Sunday is a Holy Day of Obligation. Sunday is the day of the Resurrection, and it is such an important part of living our faith, that we must assist at Mass – that is, be present at Mass both physically and mentally.

Some other teachings or dogmas of our faith are so closely united to Jesus' Paschal Mystery that we are obliged to assist at Mass on these days as well. These are "Holy Days of Obligation," and in reality, there are very few on our calendar. One of these is the **Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on August 15th**. This solemnity celebrates Mary's being taken up into heaven, body and soul, at the end of her earthly life. Sometimes the celebration of this feast day is moved to the following Sunday, but this year, it is on Wednesday, and it is a Holy Day of Obligation. There will be five opportunities to fulfill your obligation within the consortium:

August 14, 7:00 p.m. (with Confessions at 6:00 p.m.), Church of the Atonement
 August 14, 7:00 p.m. (with Confessions at 6:00 p.m.), St. Bernard
 August 15, 8:00 a.m., St. Rose
 August 15, 6:30 p.m. (with Holy Hour and Confessions at 5:15 p.m.), St. Rose
 August 15, 7:00 p.m. (with Confessions at 6:00 p.m.), St. Patrick

Let us remember to frequently go to Our Lady in prayer, asking her to intercede for us, that we live holy lives united to her Son, so that we too, may be happy with her and Jesus in heaven.

The second most important day next week, is the **FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL** at St. Rose on Friday, August 17!!! As summer winds down, and children return to their studies, let us pray for them and their teachers. We are very blessed to have such a good Catholic school in our consortium. When we let Jesus be our first teacher in our school, at home, at work and at our recreation, we simply can't go wrong.

Finally, since we want **St. Rose School** to grow and flourish for generations to come, we need to maintain the building. You might have seen the lifts around the school. We are **replacing the roof** that was 100 years old. This consists of new felt sheeting under the beautiful Ludowici tile. The tile will then be put back on, and any broken ones will be replaced with new ones.

How can we possibly afford this!? Well, it's not easy. We're using about \$86,000.00 from the school Special Projects savings account. About \$50,000.00 of that, came just recently as a gift from the estate of Msgr. Serraglio (please pray for the repose of his soul and in thanksgiving for his generosity). The other roughly \$100,000.00, will come from the St. Rose School Savings Account, leaving only about \$50,000.00 left in that account.

This needed to be done for the safety and comfort of our beloved students, and to ensure the school will be around for years to come. However, we simply cannot afford to do another big project like this again from our savings. This project was discussed with the members of the St. Rose Parish finance council that I could get ahold of, the week before I arrived here, and again in the actual first week I was here. I'll address some other financial issues very soon in the fall, but wanted to keep you aware of this type of spending as much as I am able.
