FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Throughout this week, we happen to celebrate many notable feast days on the Church's calendar. However, two are particularly important to us as a consortium. On Monday, August 20, we celebrate the feast day of **St. Bernard of Clairvaux**, and then on Thursday, August 23, we celebrate the feast day of **St. Rose of Lima**.

PROGRAM NOTE: In order to celebrate St. Bernard's day a little more festively, **Mass on Monday morning, August 20 will be the typical daily Mass at the usual time of 8:00 a.m., but will be celebrated at St. Bernard.** The Mass on Thursday will be a typical daily Mass at St. Rose at the usual time. Please come to celebrate two of our patronal feast days! (Incidentally, St. Patrick's Day falls on a Sunday this year, and there isn't Mass anywhere in the world on Church of the Atonement's patronal feast day, Good Friday!)

From a sermon by St. Bernard in the Office of Readings for August 20, "Love is sufficient of itself, it gives pleasure by itself and because of itself. It is its own merit, its own reward. Love looks for no cause outside itself, no effect beyond itself. Its profit lies in its practice. I love because I love, I love that I may love."

Loving in this way is often not familiar to the world. For the world, to love seems to be to seek pleasure for itself. Let us be inspired by these words of St. Bernard to grow in love for others without any self-seeking. If we need to be reminded what this looks like, we need only to look at a crucifix. Surely the image of the crucified Christ inspired St. Bernard, and all the saints who imitated Christ in living holiness heroically. This type of love and sanctity that the saints had is possible for us, too.

Finally, if you know of anyone who has expressed an interest in becoming Catholic, the **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.) begins on Tuesday, September 11 at 6:00 p.m. in the lower level of the PCC.** Please invite those who are interested to call the office for more information.
