**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

Each parish is required to participate in the diocesan **Missionary Cooperation Plan (MCP)** every year. This year, our missionary appeal will take place next weekend.

I realize that this comes directly after my financial state of the parish talk. That couldn't be avoided as this missionary co-op appeal was scheduled long before I arrived, and I needed to inform you of our financial position sooner rather than later.

Additionally, I am aware that we have had other "appeals" made in some, if not all, of our parishes recently when Mass coverage was needed. This seems to have been an oversight due to unfamiliarity with the diocesan policy. Subsequently, all clergy have been reminded of the policy that no missionaries are to be invited to make an appeal without diocesan approval. Moreover, any monies collected for them goes first to the Diocesan Missions Office, which then sends it directly to their religious order or apostolate. If we need Mass coverage in the future, we have priests in the diocese able to assist us.

Fr. John Tigatiga, SDS and Fr. Ferdinand Lukoa, SDS from the Society of the Divine Savior (SDS) or more popularly "The Salvatorians" will be making appeals at all Masses next weekend. They are both currently exercising their ministry in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. (Go Pack Go!)

On Saturday, September 22 and Sunday, September 23, **Fr. John Tigatiga, SDS will celebrate Mass and make an appeal at St. Bernard, St. Patrick, and the 10:30 a.m. at St. Rose. Fr. Ferdinand Lukoa, SDS will celebrate Mass and make an appeal at the 6:00 p.m. St. Rose, 7:30 p.m. St. Rose, and Church of the Atonement.**

The Salvatorians were founded by Fr. Francis Mary of the Cross Jordan on December 8, 1881, in Rome. The basis of their apostle is to spread the Gospel by all ways and means with a desire to spend themselves for the salvation of all peoples. They are an international organization with a presence in 40 different countries.

We warmly welcome Fr. John and Fr. Ferdinand and the opportunity to learn about the work of the Salvatorians. Part of the reason the Bishop mandates the missionary appeals in this way is for us to have an opportunity to hear about the work that others are doing in the wider Universal Church. We then also have an opportunity to support their efforts; please do so as generously as possible.
